SANT BABA RANJEET SINGH PUBLIC SR. SEC. SCHOOL, MULLOWAL (SANGRUR) is a co-educational secondary day school situated in Village Mullowal (Sangrur). The whole school campus is spread across lush green area of approximately 10 bighas. The sylvan setting is strikingly beautiful and ideal for an institution of this type. The school is being run on public school lines. It is managed by LOTUS EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY (REGD.), MULLOWAL (SGR.). Our school aim at turning out our students who are physically strong, known for their wisdom and are intelligent enough to take correct decision and fully aware of what is right and wrong.

Aims and Objectives :

SANT BABA RANJEET SINGH PUBLIC SR. SEC. SCHOOL, MULLOWAL (SANGRUR) is open to all without distinction of race, creed, caste or social status, with a view to

- a) Provide School education of high academic-standard to children and to promote their all round development in the background of Indian culture and religious heritage, imbibing respect for moral and ethical values in the light of the Universal teachings of spiritual Saints of India.
- b) Foster essential characteristics of Public School education, like discipline , esprit de corps, building up of character, team work, physical development, sense of chivalry, fair play, honesty, integrity in all walks of life and inculcating spirit of sacrifice and service.
- c) Promote spirit of Indian Nationalism and National solidarity by inculcating respect for all religions, tolerance, mutual co-operation in building up the Nation and emotional integration.
- d) Build up character by personal guidance, individual attention and provide facilities to students to grow up as honest, useful and patriotic citizens with a firm and religious base.

Infrastructure & Games and Sports :

The School is spread over 2 acres of land. The surroundings are picturesque as the premises are strategically placed. The school has two wings i.e. Junior and Senior:

1. Well stocked libraries with rich collection of books consisting of Encyclopedia, Handbooks, Dictionaries, Atlases & Internet facility for reference.
2. Internet facility is available in both the computer labs that are equipped with 20 P-Dual Core Networked Computers.
3. Provision for Western, Indian, Classical, Vocal Music & Dance.
4. A fully air conditioned block for Junior students.
5. School has grounds for Cricket, Badminton, Basket Ball, Roller Skating Ground and Athletic. Teams regularly perform well at District/State Level/ CBSE fixtures and SGFI games.

Co-Curricular Activities :

The School has been divided into four Clubs viz. SBRS Stars, SBRS Heros, SBRS Masters and SBRS Kings. In order to help the children develop a holistic personality, the School organizes inter club competitions in academic, cultural and physical spheres. The school enhances the inherent talent of each child by giving them opportunities to showcase their talents. The school holds Inter - Club Cultural evening, Debates, Duke of Edinburgh program for Out Reach and Out bound Activities like trekking, mountaineering, visiting Old age home, Tree Planting, Cycling expedition etc.

JUNIORS :

- SUMMER: Half sleeve Off white shirt with red check. Red check Knickers for boys and Skirt for Girls. Black school shoes with off white socks for all. Red belt with school logo. Red patka for all students.

On Wednesday and Saturday green lower with red T-shirt, white shoes, white socks, white patka for all students.

- WINTER: Full sleeve off white shirt with red check. Red check pent for boys and skirt for girls with leggy. Red cardigan for all students. Black shoes with off white socks for all. Red belt and red tie with school logo. Red cap for all students.

On Wednesday and Saturday green lower with red T shirt and Green Upper, white shoes and socks and red cap for all students.

SENIORS :

- SUMMER: Half sleeve Green check shirt. Plane Green Knickers with school name for boys and Plane Green Skirt with school name for Girls. Black school shoes with Green socks for all. Green belt with school logo. Green patka for all students and Green turbon for boys 7th onwards. Green check suit and plane green salwar for girls 9th and 10th classes with green dupatta.

On Wednesday and Saturday green lower with red T-shirt, white shoes, white socks, white patka for all students.

- WINTER: Full sleeve Green check shirt. Plane Green pent with school name for boys and Plane Green skirt with school name for girls with Green leggy. Green Blazer with school logo for all students. Black shoes with Green socks for all. Green belt with school logo and Green tie with school logo. Green cap for all students and Green turbon for boys 7th onwards. Green check suit and plane green salwar for girls 9th and 10th with green cardigan and green dupatta.

On Wednesday and Saturday For classes grey lower with red T shirt and Green Blazer, white shoes and socks and white patka for all students. For classes white pent, white shirt, white shoes and socks with white patka for boys and white skirt, white shirt, white shoes and socks with white patka for girls. White turbon for boys 7th onwards and Plane white suit and salwar for girls 9th and 10th with white dupatta.

School Rules

Every student is expected to observe the following school rules :

- Attending all the School functions is COMPULSORY, no leave will be granted, and absence will be viewed seriously. Defaulters will be issued Warning Cards.
- Absence from School is not in the interest of the students. Parents are earnestly requested not to apply for leave if they can avoid it. The leave as a rule has to be applied for and the sanction obtained. It should not be treated as a casual affair.
- Students not availing themselves of the School transport must reach the school ten minutes before the assembly bell.
- Parents are strongly advised to maintain the decorum of the institution and abide by the school rules, use of unparliamentarily language, or use of physical violence and carrying arms is strictly prohibited.
- Use of two wheelers, cars and mobile phone is banned. Defaulters will be issued warning cards or even expelled from the school.
- The Director/Principal reserves the right to strike off from rolls students whose progress is unsatisfactory and his/her behavior is not upto school norms and disciplinary action is initiated by School.
- It is compulsory for all students to pay the school fees as per the fee schedule given on fee slips.
- Student's Name, D.O.B., Father's Name, Mother's Name to be filled carefully in the admission form at the time of admission.
- The Information provided will be sent to the CBSE Board for registration and in case of any correction due to wrong entry by Parent, the legal expenses will be borne by Parents.

Admission Procedures

Admissions is normally done only in Nursery every year. In other classes, admission is strictly based on availability on seats and admission test will be conducted.

Age Eligibility : As on 1st April in the year of admission

a) Nursery years +

b) KG years +

c) Class-I years +

d) Class-II onwards :

On basis of previous class results and R.T.E. age category

Admission Test

- On the spot admission test will take in Feb., March for all classes. The test will be held in English and Mathematics and in any other subject which may be considered necessary.
- The selection of the candidates will depend upon the child's performance in the tests and availability of seats in the concerned class.
- The result of the test & the last date for the submission of fee will be specified at the time of the test. • Bus route & stops are fixed after careful study and no request for creation of new stop or change of bus stop/route during the session (April-March) will be entertained . Any request for the above should reach the school before the beginning of new session st by March 15 and the routes and stoppages would be finalized for the year by 31 March.
- Students will be held responsible for any damage caused by negligence or vandalism in the bus. Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited.
- Payment of the fees can be made through the Bank cheque and cash ONLY as per Pay-in-slip details. The Fee is to be deposited by 30 of the month as per the scheduled date of payment . Thereafter, fine of Rs. 100/- will be charged per month. If the fees along with the late fees is not paid for over 6 months in a year, then his/her name may be struck off from the school rolls automatically. If not authorized, re-admission charges will be payable if the school permits him/her to rejoin the school.
- Fee once paid is not refundable.

Withdrawal

- Parents should give at least one month notice in writing or pay a month's fee in advance before withdrawal of their ward. If however the student is asked by the school to leave, the fee will not be charged from the date of order.
- The transfer certificate will not be issued until all dues are settled and NOC is submitted.
